LENT IN OUR CHURCHES

Lent is a season of self-examination; prayer and study as we prepare for the great feast of Easter.

This year we will be exploring the **Lent Book**, *The Merciful Humility of God*, by Dr Jane Williams who is Assistant Dean and Lecturer of Systematic Theology at St Mellitus College.

In our book Dr Williams explores God's mercy and the gentle way God works with us and amongst us while encouraging us to look at our lives and our relationship with God. The clear style of the book makes it easy to understand and accessible for all people no matter how much or how little we have studied this sort of thing before.

This book will provide the material for our **Lent Course** where we will explore the book with the help of the reflections provided at the end of each of the five chapters. This will consist of a total of Five Sessions which will be offered as a series of Morning and Evening sessions allowing people to attend whichever would be most convenient to them.
