10:00 Holy Communion with Ashing St Laurence, Upwey

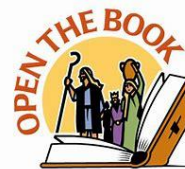
19:00 Holy Communion with Ashing Holy Trinity, Bincombe
