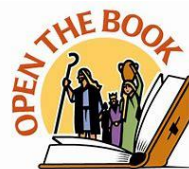
The college where Judy Parson works is having a pre-Ofsted inspection next week. This will be a stressful time for staff, so prayers would be much appreciated.
